Popular Pages: 'Casey at the Bat'

It's known as America's most famous comedic poem, and baseball fans will recognize its references to the "mighty Casey" and the "Mudville nine." Penned by Ernest L. Thayer, a humor writer for the San Francisco Examiner, "Casey at the Bat" was first published in the newspaper's June 3, 1888, edition. The rhyming tale of a baseball team counting on their star player to bring a come-from-behind victory, only to-spoiler alert!-strike out and lose the game, made its way across the country after the piece was reprinted. Vaudeville actor DeWolf Hopper made the poem a hit when he began reciting it on stage, and it became his signature act, performing it 10,000 times throughout the U.S. during his career. "Casey at the Bat" has been recorded numerous times, adapted into picture books and parodied in films and TV shows, and it's inspired several statues as well as a U.S. postage stamp.
